

Dear Member,

The Minister for Health, David Davis, has announced that 26 rural health services across Victoria will receive a \$5 million Victorian Coalition Government boost to upgrade facilities in the first round of grants from the *Rural Capital Support Fund*.

These funding grants are aimed to help hospitals, aged care facilities, and community health services upgrade amenities, implement new models of care, and increase service capacity and efficiency. The *Rural Capital Support Fund* is seen as an important part of the *Rural and Regional Health Plan*, the Victorian Coalition Government's vision to support access to quality health services in rural areas.

A list of upgrade and improvement projects to be funded in this round of grants is included below:
